Request details

Please can I request the following under the Freedom of Information Act, for the years 2017, 2018, 2019, and 2020 so far.

1. The number of reported incidents of hate crime towards hospital staff by patients.
2. Please detail what sort of hate crime, gender based, transphobic, homophobic, racist, etc – and which hospital or department this occurred in? For example A&E, maternity, children's ward, out patients.
3. If possible please detail what area the staff member worked in – such as admin, reception, doctor, consultant, or nurse, or paramedic.
4. Please detail if the police were called, and if any action was taken.

5. Also the number of reported incidents by patients of hate crimes in hospital departments – please detail the same.
