After considering your request, the UHB believes that the data requested is classed as personal data as defined under the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) and Data Protection Act 2018 and its disclosure would be contrary to the data protection principles and constitute unfair and unlawful processing in regard to Articles 5, 6, and 9 of GDPR. We are therefore withholding this detail under Section 40(2) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000. This exemption is absolute and therefore there is no requirement to apply the public interest test.

To comply with our Section 16 obligation, the duty to provide advice and assistance, you may find the following information useful.

Cardiff CRT provides the integrated care team and Reablement team resource for the Cardiff area. The team works from 2 bases within the city – Llanrumney and Whitchurch sites, however no longer works as 2 separate teams as the whole resource is now classified as Cardiff Community Resource Team. The team consists of C&V UHB staff (providing Therapy and Nurse support) and Cardiff Local Authority staff (providing Care resource).
