We would be grateful to receive copies of any **guidelines or protocols which deal with 'do not attempt CPR'** forms, including what weight is given to them and how they are to be treated by clinicians

Response Details

After considering your request, Cardiff and Vale University Health Board (the UHB) believes that Section 21 of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 applies in this instance and is refusing your request. The reason for relying on this exemption is set out below.

Under Section 21 of the Act, an organisation does not have to respond to a request if the information being sought is reasonably accessible to the applicant by other means.
