Please could you provide us with a copy of the Wound Care Pathway/Policy that was in place in September 2019?

Response Details:

Posture and Mobility Service staff work closely with Tissue Viability Teams and other Health Professionals to work jointly in supporting patients who have disability and reduced mobility /function to prevent and manage their risk of developing / healing of pressure ulcers through provision of specialist posture management seating and wheelchairs. As this is a regional service we work with teams and professionals in (Cardiff and Vale, Swansea Bay, Hywel Dda, Cwm Taff Morganwg and Powys) Health Boards.

For our prosthetics and orthotics patients who are at high risk of developing pressure ulcers either due to their underlying health condition such as diabetes, vascular disease etc. and also, due to wearing of the prostheses and orthoses for long periods we have a ALAS specific pressure ulcer pathway.
