

**Freedom of Information Act 2000 - Request Reference FoI/21/323**

**Menopause**

- 1. Are you, as the local Health Board, responsible for commissioning all services related to diagnosis and treatment of menopause in your area? If not, then can you please provide details of who does commission menopause services in your area?**

Cardiff and Vale University Health Board does not hold this information. Under our Section 16 obligation to provide advice and assistance, the UHB can inform you that, services are not commissioned in Wales.

- 2. What services for diagnosis and treatment of menopause are available in your area? This could include specialist menopause primary health care providers within GP surgeries or in local hospitals or specialist clinics.**

The UHB does not commission any specific services in Primary Care. However, the UHB can inform you that a secondary care clinic is run once per week at the University Hospital of Wales (UHW).

- 3. Is there a waiting list for specialist menopause services in your area and if so, how long for?**

The waiting list is currently 20 weeks.

- 4. Have any services related to diagnosis and treatment of menopause been closed in your area? If yes, can you provide details of what that service was and when it closed please?**

No services have been closed.

- 5. Does the Health Board have plans to open any new menopause services? If yes please provide details.**

The UHB hopes to expand services next year, but no specific plans are in place.
