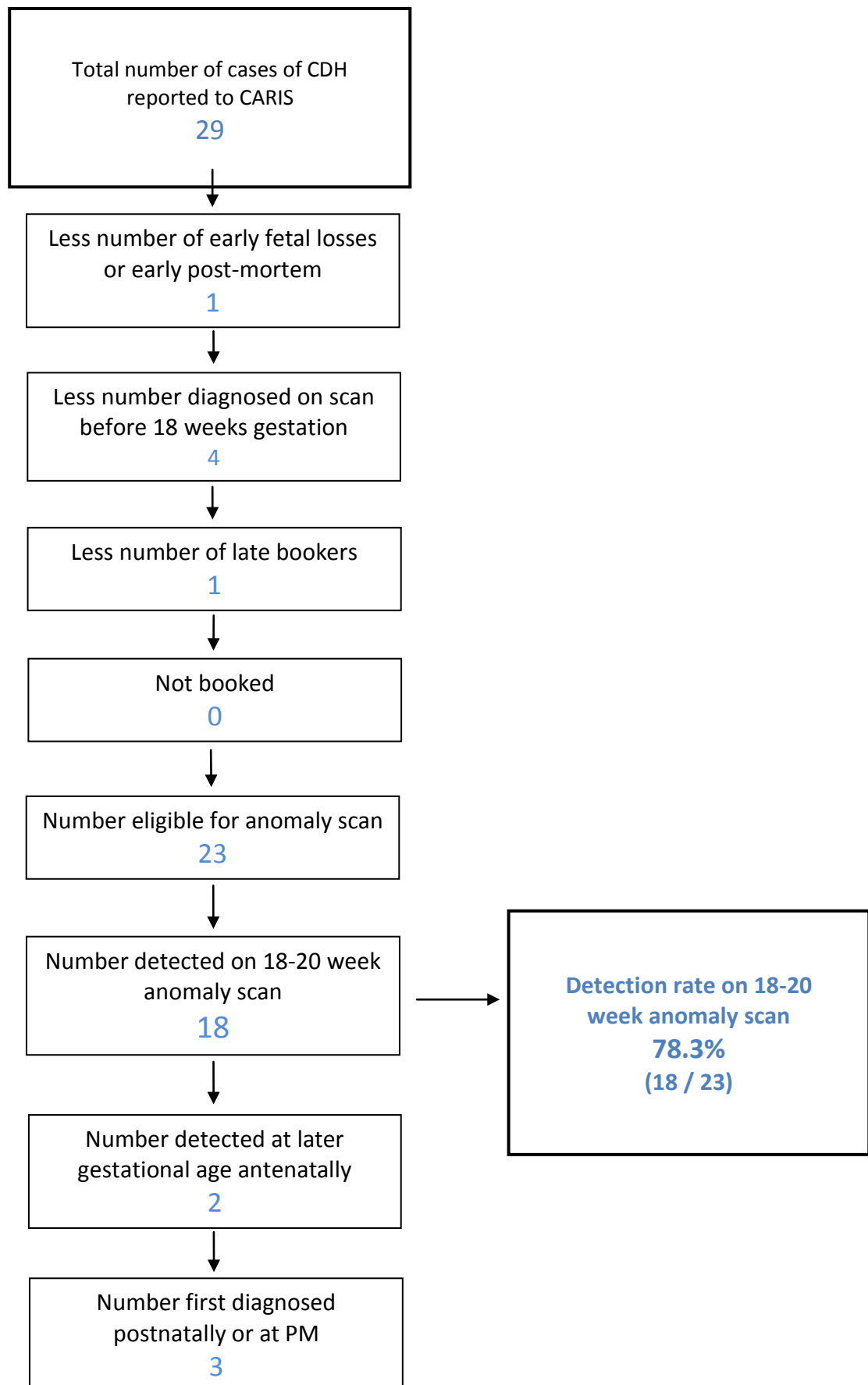


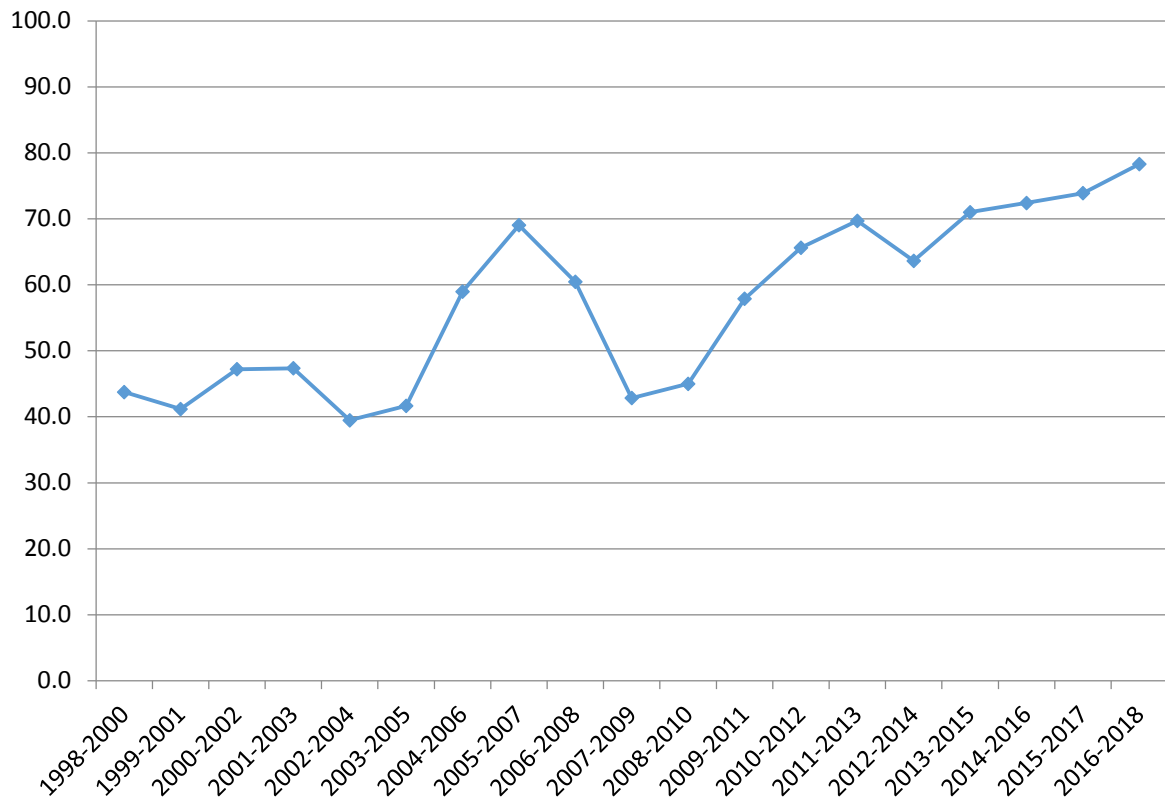
Congenital diaphragmatic hernia (CDH) – Antenatal detection rate on 18-20 week anomaly scan 2016-2018 (Wales)

Detection rate based on antenatal detection at any age of gestation = 85.7% (24/28)

Congenital diaphragmatic hernia – Antenatal detection rate on 18-20 week anomaly scan 1998-2018, based on eligibility for 18-20 week anomaly scan



Congenital diaphragmatic hernia is a serious and often lethal anomaly. It is the more severe cases that are easier to detect on antenatal ultrasound. There are 9 cases per year in Wales on average. The fluctuation seen in the detection rate is in part due to small numbers. Generally detection has improved over the years and the rate is now over 70%.
