Please can you provide the following information?

For the last 10 years, or as many years as you have for that period, which you have data please provide a breakdown of:

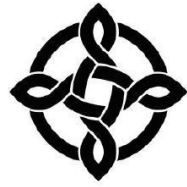
1. The number of Adult ADHD Assessments undertaken per year for up to the last 10 years. Ideally per calendar year.
2. The number of Adult ADHD Assessments for women undertaken per year for up to the last 10 years. Ideally per calendar year.
3. The number of Adult ADHD Assessments for men undertaken per year for up to the last 10 years. Ideally per calendar year.
4. The number of Children ADHD Assessments undertaken per year for up to the last 10 years. Ideally per calendar year.
5. The number of Children (Under 18) ADHD Assessments for girls undertaken per year for up to the last 10 years. Ideally per calendar year.
6. The number of Children (Under 18) ADHD Assessments for boys undertaken per year for up to the last 10 years. Ideally per calendar year.

Response Details:

In completing a search for the information requested, Cardiff and Vale University Health Board (the UHB) has confirmed that this information is not centrally recorded or collated. To retrieve the information requested would require a manual search through individual patient referrals and the UHB considers that this would exceed the limit set within regulations for responding to a request. The UHB has therefore relied upon the Section 12 exemption ('Exemption where cost of compliance exceeds appropriate limit') of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 and is refusing your request.

The UHB has estimated that to complete the work needed to respond to this request would exceed the time limit as set within regulations to respond to a Freedom of Information Act request. Under the Act there is an allowance of two and a half days, or 18 hours, to comply with a request and the cost limit set within the fees regulations for this amount of work (18 hours) is £450 for the UHB. The fees regulations specify that the cost of complying with a request must be calculated at the rate of £25 per hour.

However, under our Section 16 obligation, the duty to provide advice and assistance, I can inform you that the UHB has an estimated average of 600 referrals per month in secondary care and 1000 per month in Primary Mental Health Support Service (PMHSS) alone, this does not include Primary Care liaisons or specialist services.
