

<u>Freedom of Information Act 2000 - Request Reference Fol/22/180</u> Pulmonary Rehab Services

I'd like to please request the following information with regards to the pulmonary rehab services your patients have access to.

1) Who commissions the Pulmonary Rehab services your patients have access to and who provides these services?

We do not have a commissioning process in the NHS in Wales as they do in England. The assessment, planning, funding and monitoring is done by respective secondary care health boards.

2) When did the services first commence?

The service started in 2001.

3) How many patients have been referred to the service in the last 12 months and 24 months of data held?

From 1 April 2021 - 31 March 2022, 204 patients have been referred to pulmonary rehab and from 1 April 2020 - 31 March 2022, a total of 338 patients were referred.

4) Of these being referred how many have actually attended the service in these same time periods?

Of those referred from 1 April 2021 - 31 March 2022, 8 patients have attended and those referred from 1 April 2020 - 31 March 2022, 55 have attended since we re-opened in October 2020 after closing during the Covid-19 pandemic.

5) How long does the average patient stay within the services?

Patients attend rehab for a six-week period.

6) What is the current waiting list size for the service?

280 patients are currently on pulmonary rehabilitation waiting list.



7) What is the current remaining contract durations for these services?

There is no contract duration that we have within our own health board.

8) Has the CCG ever commissioned Digital Respiratory Services?

If so were these for Pulmonary Rehab?

If so who were the providers?

If so how many patients have utilised this digital element?

The UHB do not have a CCG and have never formally commissioned a digital PR program.
