**Information Requested:**

What are the numbers of young people we have in Wales with Cystic Fibrosis (CF).

**Response details:**

Cardiff and Vale University Health Board (the UHB) does not hold this information. Under Section 16 of the FOIA, which provides us with the duty to advise and assist, the UHB can inform you that we utilize an All Wales adult service and can only provide estimates, there may be 1-2 patients in smaller paediatric units across Wales of which we are unaware. Please also note that North Wales paediatric and young adult (17-18) CF patients would attend Alder Hey (Liverpool) and Liverpool Adult CF Centre for their care.
