Information Requested:

I write regarding a Freedom of Information request about the suspension of breast cancer screening services during COVID-19 and would be grateful if you could provide me with the following information:

- 1. How many women were eligible for population breast cancer screening services (i.e. between the ages of 50 and 71) between March 2020 and June 2021?
- 2. How many women had their breast cancer screening delayed between March 2020 and June 2021?
- 3. Will you provide a breakdown of delays by month of breast cancer screening services between March 2020 and June 2021?
- 4. How many breast cancer screening services suspended invitations for population screening in your local health board area during this time and when did they resume invitations?
