Information Requested:

I am writing to you under the Freedom of Information Act 2000. On the 17th June 2022, Virtus Tech Ltd posted a Tweet stating that your organisation has signed up to Wales Virtual Hospital. I am writing to request the following information:

1. What is the cost of the product (Wales Virtual Hospital) to your organisation, what does the cost include and over what period of time?
2. Have you signed a commercial agreement for use of Wales Virtual Hospital with Virtus Tech Ltd or any organisation acting on their behalf?
3. When making the decision to use Wales Virtual Hospital, did you compare the product against market alternatives? If so, which others and if not, why not?
4. What evidence were you presented with by Virtus Tech Ltd or any other organisation acting on their behalf, that Wales Virtual Hospital is suitable and effective for the needs of your organisation?
