Staff details for woundcare

Information Requested:

I am looking for details of who sits on the decision-making board for the woundcare formulary or framework.

Response Details:

After considering your request, the UHB believes that the data requested is classed as personal data as defined under the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) and Data Protection Act 2018 and its disclosure would be contrary to the data protection principles and constitute unfair and unlawful processing in regard to Articles 5, 6, and 9 of GDPR. We are therefore withholding this detail under Section 40(2) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000. This exemption is absolute and therefore there is no requirement to apply the public interest test.

Under Section 16 of the FOIA, which provides us with the duty to advise and assist, Cardiff and Vale University Health Board (the UHB) can inform you that the wound care formulary sits within Wound Healing.

All wound management products are procured in accordance with the All Wales Wound Management team in shared services contract. They need to be on the contract for the UHB to add them to the formulary, though there are some exceptions to this.

A formulary application then needs to be made to the medicines management team which is then taken to Clinical Boards for consideration.
