

**Freedom of Information Act 2000 - Request Reference FoI/23/411**  
**Huntington's disease**

**Information Requested:**

On 14th July I submitted a Freedom of Information request to the Ministry of Justice (MoJ) regarding the number of prisoners in Wales with a Huntington's disease diagnosis. I today received a response stating that they do not keep this information. They have suggested: "For public sector prisons in Wales, you should direct your request to the relevant Local Health Boards. These are:

- Abertawe Bro Morgannwg University Health Board for HMP Swansea
- Aneurin Bevan University Health Board for HMP Usk and Prescoed
- Cardiff and Vale University Health Board for HMP Cardiff
- Betsi Cadwaladr University Health Board for HMP Berwyn"

**Response Details:**

Cardiff and Vale University Health Board can confirm that, as of 30<sup>th</sup> August 2023, HMP Cardiff does not have any patients with a diagnosis of Huntington's disease.
