

**Freedom of Information Act 2000 – Request Reference FoI/23/651**  
**Sentinel Stroke National Audit Programme (SSNAP) Data**

**Information Requested:**

Under the Freedom of Information Act 2000, we write to formally request a copy of the SSNAP data from the University Hospital of Wales for the period from July to September 2016. Please provide the spreadsheet for this period.

In addition, please specifically provide the below information:

1. Scanning key indicators including the median time between clock start and scan
2. Percentage of patients scanned within 1 hour
3. Thrombolysis key indicators including the percentage of all stroke patients thrombolysed within 1 hour
4. Median time between clock start and thrombolysis
5. Median time between clock start and being assessed by a stroke Consultant

**Response Details:**

After considering your request for SSNAP data, Cardiff and Vale University Health Board (the UHB) believes that section 21 of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 applies in this instance and is refusing your request.

Under section 21 of the Act, a public authority does not have to respond to a request if the information being sought is reasonably accessible to the applicant by other means. The UHB has applied this exemption to your request as the information you are seeking is available in the public domain. Under our section 16 obligation to advise and assist, I can confirm that the relevant data can be found at the below weblinks.
