The UHB does not have an "officer with responsibility for Social Care Telecare Analogue to Digital transition". In accordance with our duty to advise and assist under section 16 of the Freedom of Information Act 2000, the UHB can inform you that this responsibility sits with relevant local authorities as they deliver social care. After considering your request for emails and telephone numbers, the UHB believes that the data requested is classed as personal data as defined under the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) and Data Protection Act 2018. Its disclosure would be contrary to the data protection principles and constitute unfair and unlawful processing in regard to Articles 5, 6, and 9 of GDPR. We are therefore withholding this detail under section 40(2) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000. This exemption is absolute and therefore there is no requirement to apply the public interest test.
