Yes I'm aware of the unfortunate situation.
We have discussed and we will need the info related to HIV - we would continue to ask for new diagnoses and transferred on a request we would send monthly so if staff could note on a spreadsheet that is all we would ask. We will be able to pull lab data for viral load and CD4 information related to these cases.

For wider STI reporting we will also take the information from the lab data system directly so we will have numbers testing and infection identified from there rather than from the clinic system. Assuming samples are gender identified and have dates of birth we will be able to report on age and gender at least from the lab data as well rather than having reports from the clinic.

Hopefully this will take some of the pressure off the clinic system

We are working on business continuity.

Clearly, we need to avoid any additional strain on the millcare system given that as of 5pm today, we have no access to technical support if the system fails.

One option to reduce pressure on the system is reducing requirement for production of national reports. I understand from [REDACTED] that we have info in respect of the HIV cohort but there is a risk in causing stress to the system if we are required to provide additional reports at this time.

Please can you confirm what level of restricted reporting will be acceptable
