Information Requested:

Please could you provide the details of the circumstances under which, and the extent to which, you will engage with parents of children Enfys is supporting, or considering supporting.

This includes, but is not limited to, whether you will accept information from parents which may be relevant to the support you offer, and whether you will discuss what type support may be most useful or appropriate to children.

Response Details:

Cardiff and Vale University Health Board (the UHB) does not hold this information. The Freedom of Information Act 2000 gives individuals the right to access information held in recorded form by a public authority, subject to any exemptions within the Act, at the time of request. A public authority does not have to generate new information which does not already exist.

However, anecdotally, the UHB can inform you that the Enfys team's work is decided upon in collaboration with the local authorities at panels and our assessments dictate the best evidence-based interventions. Sometimes this involves work with a biological family. Whether to involve a biological family and the extent of their involvement is determined on a case-by-case basis.
