- 2. Is this training mandatory?**

Yes.

- 3. What percentage of patient-facing staff have completed this training? Please break down by clinical and non-clinical.**

66.91% in total, 65.27% for clinical staff, and 76.32% for non-clinical staff.

- 4. What percentage of GP practice-based staff have completed this training? Please break down by clinical and non-clinical.**

73.74% in total, 70.98% for clinical staff, and 82.16% for non-clinical staff.

- 5. What percentage of staff based at Roath House Surgery, 100 Penylan Road in Cardiff, have completed this training? Please break down by clinical and non-clinical.**
