Aseptic Non-Touch Technique Assessment

Information Requested:

I am interested in hospital acquired infections and would like to know from the ESR training data base on average *how many attempts* do the following groups of staff take to pass the ANTT assessment on the all-Wales e-learning 000 NHS Wales - Aseptic Non-Touch Technique (ANTT):

- Unregistered staff (Bands 2-4).
- Nurses.
- Doctors.

Response Details:

The All Wales e-learning 000 NHS Wales – Aseptic Non-Touch Technique (ANTT) has been developed with assessment throughout the learning, therefore specific data on *just* the assessment attempts cannot be accessed.

However, having run a 'Player Detail Analysis' report from Electronic Staff Record for the staff groups requested with one-year worth of data, totalling up the number of attempts and dividing by the number of members of staff in the groups produced the following results – please note that this is an average for the number of attempts for the staff groups:

- Unregistered staff (bands 2 to 4) – 2.15 attempts
- Nurses – 1.93 attempts
- Doctors – 1.86 attempts

It is also worth noting that the number of attempts may also be the number of attempts made (without distraction) to complete the e-learning.
