*Argos: BT Big Button Corded Telephone (£27.99)*

*This phone has an easy to use speakerphone function with hearing aid compatibility and is suitable for mild to moderate losses.*



*RNID website: Doro Magna 4000 Amplified telephone (£80)*

*This phone has an easy to use speakerphone function and will amplify phone calls +90dB. This phone is more suitable for severe to profound losses.*

## Doorbells

*Argos: Uni-Com Premium Portable and Plug-in Doorbell Set (£35)*



*This doorbell has two alarms, one which can be plugged in and another which is portable. This doorbell also comes with a flashing light on the alarm. This doorbell is suitable for mild to moderate hearing losses*



*RNID website: Geemarc Amplicall 20 ring indicator with remote doorbell push (£59.99)*

*This doorbell is suitable for severe to profound losses as it has an extra loud ringer (up to +95dB) and a flashing light indicator. This doorbell can also be used with a vibrating pad (purchased separately).*

## Shake and Awake Alarm clocks



*Argos: Lifemax Under Pillow Vibration Alarm Clock (£19.99)*

*This alarm clock can be placed underneath your pillow and a vibrating alarm will prompt you to wake up, an additional audible setting can be switched on.*



*RNID website: Geemarc Wake 'n' Shake Star Alarm Clock (£49.99)*

*This alarm clock has a vibrating pad which is placed under the pillow to assist in waking you up. Alongside this the alarm also has flashing lights and an audible alarm which has 3 levels of volume (up to +95dB)*
