- An Access to Work grant could help pay for any assistive devices or communication support you need at work, and your employer will make these changes to support you.
- If you have hearing loss, Access to Work may be able to cover the cost of any assistive devices that you need to do your job. This could include, for example, a listening device or loop system to help you hear during meetings.

Who can get Access to Work?

- If you're 16 or over and have a condition that affects your ability to work.
- You need to have a paid job, or be about to start or return to one.
