Changes to Medline and other OVID Databases from 1st December

The following databases on the NHS Wales e-library have been moved from the OVID interface to Proquest:

- EMBASE
- Medline
- PsycINFO
- AMED

This change has been made as a result of a regular contract renewal process carried out by the NHS Wales e-library.

The NHS Wales e-Library still subscribes to other products on OVID, so you won't lose access to your personal account. You will be able to see your saved searches, but unfortunately they will not transfer to the new Proquest platform.

Training is being arranged for the new Proquest interface during the week 14th – 18th December, and will be recorded. Dates and times will be announced.


