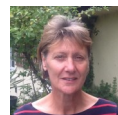

The Graham Bull prize was established in 1988 in honour of Sir Graham Bull, who was the first director of the Clinical Research Centre at Northwick Park. A trust was set up to provide money for young research workers under the age of 45 who feel that they have made a major contribution to clinical science, such as molecular and cellular biology, psychiatry or health sciences. The winner will be invited to deliver the Goulstonian lecture, an annual lecture endowed in 1635 by Ellen Goulston in memory of her husband, Dr Theodore Goulston FRCP; and win £1,000, which is offered on a competitive basis each year.
