

Freedom of Information Act 2000 - Request Reference FoI/21/041
Covid-19 Vaccinations

Request details

I have an FOI request for the below statements:

NHS Staff Vaccination Questions:

- 1. How many NHS staff qualified as a Band One have had the vaccine so far at the Health Board.**
- 2. How many NHS staff qualified as a Band Two have had the vaccine so far at the Health Board.**
- 3. How many NHS staff qualified as a Band Three have had the vaccine so far at the Health Board.**
- 4. How many NHS staff qualified as a Band Five have had the vaccine so far at the Health Board.**
- 5. How many NHS staff qualified as a Band Six have had the vaccine so far at the Health Board.**
- 6. How many NHS staff qualified as a Band Seven have had the vaccine so far at the Health Board.**
- 7. How many NHS staff qualified as a Band Eight (A-D) have had the vaccine so far at the Health Board.**
- 8. How many NHS staff qualified as a Band Nine have had the vaccine so far at the Health Board.**

In completing a search for the information requested, Cardiff and Vale University Health Board (the UHB) has confirmed that this information is not centrally recorded or collated. To retrieve the information requested would require a manual search through individual records and the UHB considers that this would exceed the limit set within regulations for responding to a request. The UHB has therefore relied upon the Section 12 exemption ('Exemption where cost of compliance exceeds appropriate limit') of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 and is refusing your request.

The UHB has estimated that to complete the work needed to respond to this request would exceed the time limit as set within regulations to respond to a Freedom of Information Act request. Under the Act there is an allowance of two and a half days, or 18 hours, to comply with a request and the cost limit set within the fees regulations for this amount of work (18 hours) is £450 for the UHB. The fees regulations specify that the cost of complying with a request must be calculated at the rate of £25 per hour.

Vaccinations Questions:

- 1. How much of the Pzifer vaccinations have been ordered so far?**

60 trays (70,200 doses – 6 dose)

2. How many of the Oxford vaccinations have been ordered so far?

39,400 of 10 dose and 13,920 of 8 dose.

3. How many NHS staff were due to get their second jab of the Pfizer vaccine, but due to changes have not received their second vaccination?

Second doses will commence 15th February.

4. How many Pfizer vaccinations have been thrown out/disposed of/destroyed so far?

One vial of Pfizer vaccine has been destroyed due to coring of the vial bung

5. How many of the above have been in the last week.
