

To the parents/guardians of autistic children

Please see attached letter, which briefly describes the EEG test. It might be helpful to either visit the department or talk to a member of staff on the telephone prior to the test to discuss your child's particular needs and requirements. We need the child to be co-operative to enable the physiologist to apply a minimum of 12 (or 25) electrodes to the head. You may be able to give us some guidance on stimulants so that these can be avoided or removed from the room or you may be able to suggest what might calm your child.

If the child responds well to a particular person we can re-arrange the appointment to accommodate this person.
