

What is a SNOD/SR?

A SNOD is a Specialist Nurse in Organ Donation. Their role is to support end-of-life decisions of patients and their families, to help save or improve lives of others by facilitating the donation process. Extended roles include the provision of education and support for staff and hospital audit.

Our University Hospital Wales embedded SNODs are Charlotte Goodwin, Clare Morris, Gail Melvin and Katie Edwards.

An SR is a Specialist Requestor and are a special branch of SNOD. They are deployed to donor referrals first, to support and approach families for donation. It is based on the principle that concentrated training, practice, exposure and fewer people undertaking the role will increase expertise and therefore consent rates.

In University Hospital Wales our embedded SR is Lucy Barnes.
