- 2) Call Blood Bank

Out of hours Call 3333 and state "Fast bleep Blood Bank on 5268"

- 2) To Lab staff state:

- a) Name/ role of 'Coordinator'
- b) "Activate EU Paediatric Massive Haemorrhage Protocol"
- c) Confirm "Neonate" "Infant" or "Child"
- d) "Location EU Resus" ext 41916/ 41958
- e) Consultant in charge

- 3) Send EU 'Runner' to Blood Bank with 'Unknown' patient addressograph label

On PORTERTRAC

- 1) Click "New task"
- 2) In "Task type" box Select MHPRES Massive Haemorrhage Resus
- 3) In "Patient name" box Select "N/A"

Porter will attend EU Resus room and await further instruction from the Senior Doctor

Senior Doctor and Senior Nurse in Resus:

- 1) Stand down Blood Bank and Porters when appropriate
- 2) Provide FULL patient information to Laboratory staff at the END of the resuscitation phase.
- 3) Ensure Traceability labels returned to Blood Bank
