Electronic reporting

Background information

MOVEit® DMZ Enterprise is a secure file transfer server. It safely and securely collects, stores, manages, and distributes sensitive information such as laboratory reports between organisations.

The software resides on a Microsoft Windows Server platform and the files are exchanged over encrypted connections. All that is required is a computer with internet access and an email address

An email alert is sent to one or more designated individuals to let you know that results are available on the server for you to access. You can then access the password protected server to view the results as PDF files, which can be printed or copied and pasted into your own laboratory information system.

Start up

On receipt of the completed proformas the IT department at University Hospital of Wales will arrange access to the secure file server. You will then receive a "welcome" email that explains how to use the system.

Maintaining the system

Users are expected to log in at least monthly to maintain their accounts, otherwise accounts can be automatically suspended and then deleted. Users will receive emails before this happens as a reminder to log in.

Paper reports will continue to be sent for 1 month following activation of the account.
