Greenwich Leisure Limited (GLL) Corporate Scheme FAQs Operated on behalf of Cardiff Council (formerly Active Cardiff)

What is the GLL Corporate Scheme?

It is a monthly payment scheme which allows you to use the facilities at any of Cardiff Council's 8 sports and leisure facilities – as often as you like and at a time to suit you.

What does it cost?

The price per month is £27.50 (as at April 2018).

What does it include?

Unlimited use of the swimming pools, Health and Fitness Suites (including induction to the Fitness Suites and personalised training programme) and a choice of over 450 group fitness classes to suit all styles and abilities each week.

Where can I use my membership?

At the following Better centres:

Eastern, Fairwater LC, Llanishen LC, Pentwyn LC, Western LC, Maindy Centre, Penylan Library & Community Centre and Splott Hub and Pool.

How do I apply?

You can obtain an application form at any of the 8 GLL facilities and join that day! You will need a recent payslip (within the last 3 months) or Staff ID Card as proof of employment plus additional proof of address, for example driving licence, bank statement or utility bill.

What if I am already a current member?

You will be able to change down to the reduced monthly payment of £27.50. GLL will make all necessary arrangements in this respect once you have submitted your completed form. There will be no need to cancel your existing direct debit.

What happens if my circumstances change and I am no longer employed by the health board?

GLL will be informed of your change of circumstances. They will then contact you to inform you that your payment rate will be subject to change (if you wish to continue holding a membership).
