# PERSONAL REQUIREMENTS

- To have excellent listening skills and be non-judgemental.
- To be confident when communicating with service user, visitors, staff and general members of the public.
- To be enthusiastic about the aims and work of Cardiff and Vale UHB.
- To display levels of empathy and understanding at all times.
- To be presentable, smart and always wearing UHB uniform and ID badge.
- To recognise when to refer issues and questions to UHB staff.

### **DRAWING IN HOSPITALS**

This Project piloted last year with great success with feedback from patients saying or showing they enjoyed the sessions. The sessions take place in the day rooms of various hospital wards across our hospital sites, with patients invited to participate. The focus is on the drawing itself rather than the finished product.

It is important to remember that these sessions are not art classes but an opportunity for people to come together, concentrate, socialise and have autonomy over how and what they draw.

The purpose of the project is to relieve boredom, get creative, try something new and have meaningful activity.

You do not have to be an artist to apply for this role - we are looking for confident, enthusiastic and patient volunteers from any background and with any interest

### **OUTLINE OF DUTIES**

The overall aim of the role is to act as a facilitator for drawing sessions, volunteering with patients, organising ongoing drawing projects in the day room on the ward.

### **MAIN TASKS**

- To treat all service users with dignity, spending time in general conversation and listening.
- Providing feedback to staff.
- To inform staff if a service user appears unwell.
- To organise drawing sessions, including liaison with staff about session timings, identifying suitable patients, preparing the room, planning the sessions and tidying away and storing the equipment at the end.
- To engage the patients in participating and encourage their involvement with the group.















### TRAINING AND SUPPORT

Volunteers will need to undertake Cardiff and Vale University Health Board Training and Induction as well as the half day Dementia Training.

Training needs will be identified through the supervision process and me through Cardiff and Vale UHB Training Programmes.
