# Banking Personal

The **24 hour ATM point** for personal banking is located in the square/compass point main corridor. The ATM is secure and provides a fully operational FREE service to users.

There is also an ATM machine in the foyer of Hafan-y-Coed

Access is via the temporary main entrance walk to the central point of the main corridor ground floor.

# **Car Parking**

An Automatic Number Plate Recognition (ANPR) camera system is in place at University Hospital Llandough (UHL). The private parking management company ParkingEye is managerially responsible for the enforcement of any breach of the University Hospital Llandough (UHL) parking regulations.

Staff car parking administration service remains with Patient Experience and is based at UHW telephone number Ext 47739 or email UHB Parking Office (Cardiff and Vale UHB – Security).

- Currently no parking permits are required for the UHL site.
- The hospital has zoned patient, visitor and staff parking.
- Patient parking is restricted to 4 hours; in certain circumstances this can be altered. See appendix ii.

# Appeals Process.

ParkingEye has ultimate responsibility for managing their appeals process to a conclusion. Appeals can be made via the following methods:

Staff attending UHW on a regular basis, will be required to display a yellow parking permit to be able to park at UHW at staff rates. Parking Permit Application Forms remain available from:

- The UHB Car Parking Intranet Webpage.
- The Cardiff University (CU) Intranet.
- Concourse Reception Desk, UHW.
- Permit collection is from Pembroke House
- Staff who enter into a formal Car Sharing Arrangement, by completing a Car Share Application Form, are effectively reducing the number of cars coming on site, and in recognition of this will be allocated a Multi Storey (Car Park 9) parking permit.
