

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Nebuliser Hygiene in Cystic Fibrosis

Keeping your nebuliser clean and sterile is important to help the device work optimally and prevent (re)infection of the lungs. These evidence based guidelines will help keep you and your nebuliser happy and healthy.

4) Disinfection

Using an electric bab



and after using or cleaning the nebuliser. This will reduce the chance of transferring bacteria, such as *staph aureus*, onto the device, which can cause infection.

2) Washing

Nebulisers should be washed in warm water and dishwashing liquid **after each use**. This removes any visible dirt or grime, which can clog the mesh inside the nebuliser, reducing its difficiency. Washing should not be done in the bathroom. Using a sink could also risk getting bacteries, such as *pseudomones*, on the nebuliser. Therefore it is recommended you use a dedicated bowl in your Kitchen at home, or a disposable bowl in the main

3) Removal of waste

ater should be discarded do ilet and flushed with the lid therwise, bacteria will be rosolised back into the air o ushing, and could be inhaled to the lungs. A sluice is also a itable alternative in hospital

5) Storage Nebuliser parts should be kept in the steamer until next use. If removed they could be recontaminated by bacteria and therefore cause an infection when the nebuliser next used.
