Our services include...

- ① **Communication Support** - we can book BSL interpreters, Lipspeakers, Speech to Text Reporters, BSL Translators & Notetakers for appointments.
- ① Setting up and supporting **Hard of Hearing support & social groups** across Wales.
- ① **BSL & Deaf Awareness classes** for individuals & organisations.
- ① **Activity courses** for Deaf & hard of hearing children
- ① **Improve accessibility** by working with other organisations such as Action on Hearing Loss, British Deaf Association, British Tinnitus Association, National Deaf Children's Society and local Health Boards
- ① **Employment Project** - To up skill, help and support Deaf & hard of hearing people into employment or voluntary work
- ① **Provide support for general enquiries** that involves hearing loss. If we cannot help directly, we will signpost to organisations that can help. This can be anything from hearing equipment questions to information on your local sensory services team.
- ① **Sign Language Wales book** - a physical book and digital app which features signs frequently used in Wales, created by us. (captions available in both Welsh & English)
