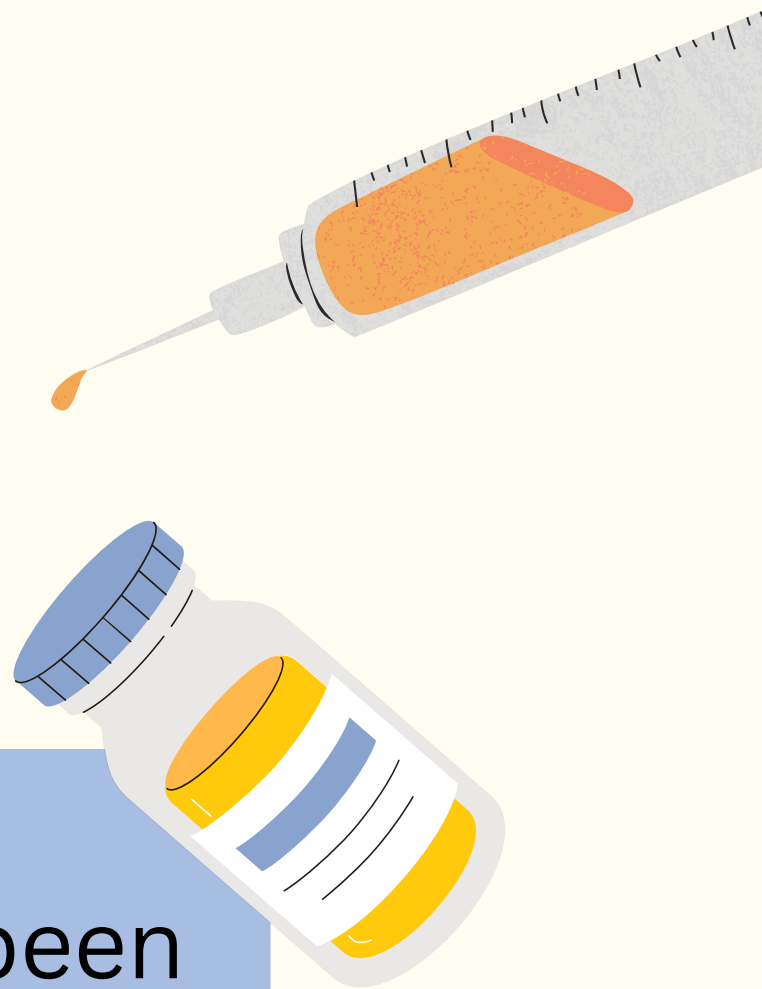


MENB VACCINE AND GONORRHOEA



What is the MenB vaccine?

The MenB (Bexsero®) vaccine has been recommended nationally for some people at higher risk of gonorrhoea because earlier studies suggested it may offer partial protection

What does the current evidence show?

Newer research has raised questions about how effective the vaccine is in preventing gonorrhoea. While this evidence is being reviewed, Cardiff and Vale Sexual Health Service is not currently prioritising routine MenB vaccination solely for gonorrhoea prevention
