after Ureteric Stent Removal

After-care:

- For the next 24-48 hours you may experience:
 - Burning or stinging when passing urine.
 - A warm bath or applying a warm damp washcloth to the urethral opening may offer some relief.
 - Blood-stained urine.
- You may notice some lower abdominal pain for which you can take regular paracetamol.
- You should aim to drink around 3 litres over the next 24 hours to reduce infection risk, unless advised otherwise.
- Avoid strenuous activities for a few days.

Contact your GP, 111 or the Surgical Hub if you experience:

- Worsening pain on urination.
- Fever.
- Offensive smelling or cloudy urine.
- Ongoing or worsening bleeding.
